

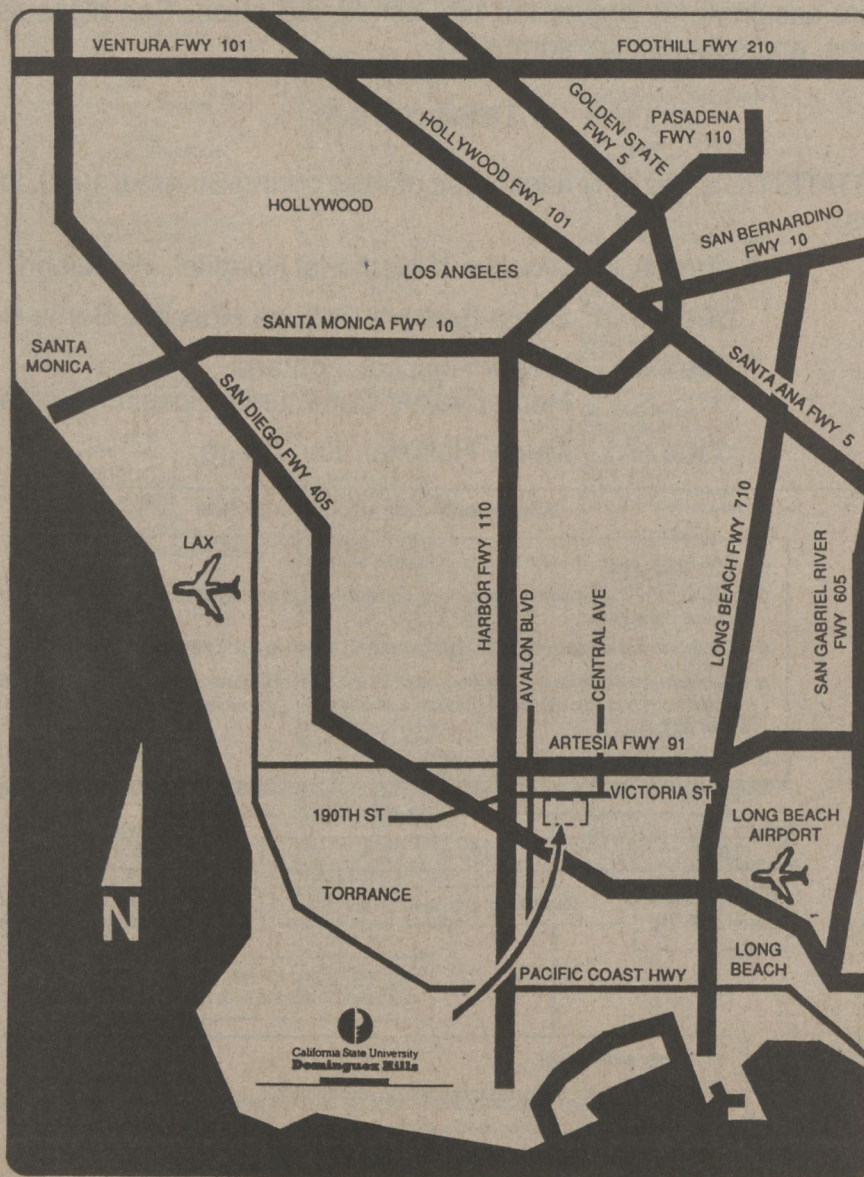

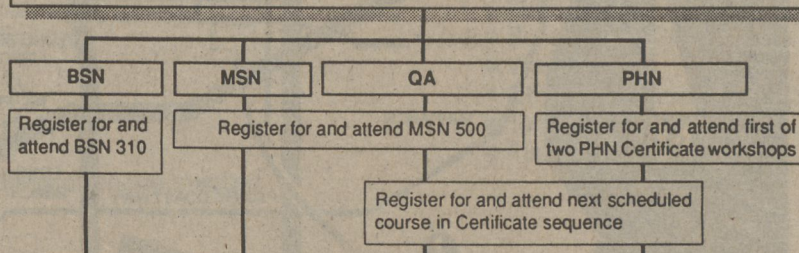

SPECIAL TOPICS COURSES

BSN 495: HEALTH ASSESSMENT OF INFANT AND PRESCHOOL CHILD(1)

This one unit course was developed for students having completed an adult health assessment course and now want to gain knowledge and experience in assessment of the infant and child. Utilizing the nursing process as a framework, the student will be able to assess developmental status, integrate laboratory findings, and apply critical thinking skills to analyze the infant's or child's status as well as monitor, refer and resolve health problems.

If you are responsible for the health management of infants and children, whether in the acute care setting or the community, this special topics course, offered in a one-day workshop format and accompanied by a complete syllabus, will provide you with new knowledge and tools for practice.

Handbook of Pediatric Primary Care (by Chavis) is strongly recommended text for the course. Use Book Order Form to obtain the book and the required syllabus.

• RNs active in program (application on file) earn one semester unit of undergraduate academic credit, which may be applied toward the undergraduate degree as an elective course.

• RNs interested in taking courses, need CE credit for relicensure, do not plan to earn a degree or have not made a firm education commitment, may enroll through Open University. Fee is \$80.00 per unit and academic credit is awarded upon successful completion of the course. This extension credit may be transferred to a degree program. Grade reports are provided and a permanent record of attendance is maintained at CSU Dominguez Hills, Division of Extended Education.

PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

The Statewide Nursing Program offers a certificate program in public health nursing. Current regulations for public health nurse certification require that the nurse be a BSN graduate of a NLN accredited nursing program. Recognizing the fact that other groups of nurses should be eligible, the Statewide Nursing Program and the State of California, Department of Health Services, have jointly developed the program described herein. **This certificate program is administered by Kathleen Johnston, Associate Director.**

To be eligible for this certificate program, applicants must: (1) hold a current R.N. license from the California Board of Registered Nursing and (2) hold a bachelor's degree under one of the following conditions:

- BSN graduate from a non-N.L.N. accredited program offered by an accredited U.S. institution.
- Baccalaureate graduate with a degree from an accredited institution.
- Graduate of a BSN program from an accredited foreign institution. Foreign transcripts will be sent directly to an International Evaluation Service. The program will then perform transfer unit evaluation and the general education analysis. More information will be sent regarding this process upon receipt of the application.

Registered Nurses interested in applying must attend a certificate workshop PRIOR to applying to the Public Health Nurse Program. The workshops are held at various sites. **Students must bring a copy of all of their transcripts to the workshop.** Each applicant is required to attend one morning workshop of counseling/advisement where previous coursework will be assessed for possible substitution. In addition, an orientation to the Statewide Nursing Program and its certificate program will be given. At the workshop you will be advised regarding the formal admissions process. Official admission into the program will depend upon the evaluation of your transcripts and verification of your bachelor's degree by the Statewide Nursing Program Admissions and Records Office. **Attending the workshop does not constitute official acceptance into the program.**

Following the workshop, persons interested in applying to the certificate program must complete the following steps to initiate admission consideration for the program: (1) submit a completed admission application with fee; check the box labeled CERTIFICATE under program objective; (2) attach a photocopy of your current California Registered Nurse license; (3) arrange for your previous college(s) to send your official transcripts directly to the SNP Admissions and Records Office. **(Ask for a second set to be sent to your home if you do not already have your own copy. You can take this copy of the transcripts to the workshop).**

If you have foreign transcripts, which have not yet been analyzed by an approved international evaluation agency you must allow at least four months (one term) for these documents to arrive at the SNP Admissions and Records Office and be evaluated by the international evaluation agency. Contact the SNP Admissions and Records Office for procedures and fees. **APPLY AT LEAST ONE TERM PRIOR FOR ADMISSION INTO THE PHN CERTIFICATE PROGRAM** if you have foreign documents.

Once you have been admitted to the program, you must take at least one unit to be a matriculated student. If you do not take a course, your admission will be void and it will be necessary for you to reapply to the program for the next term. In this case, attendance at a second workshop is not necessary.

Potential applicants must attend the morning certificate workshop. **An afternoon, same-day workshop is required for those RNs selecting the PHN certificate-only option.** The cost of each workshop is \$45. Enrollment in the first required course is permitted when eligibility has been determined and the workshop requirement has been met.

Courses required for the certificate program may be met by SNP coursework or by substitution with transferable courses from other collegiate programs. The required courses are:

A certificate-clearance check must be completed by the Admissions and Records office one term prior to the term you plan to complete the certificate program.

The certificate clearance application fee is \$10. Students will receive an evaluation which will indicate any remaining requirements, outstanding fees or other obligations which must be resolved before the certificate recommendation can be granted.

Included with your letter from Admissions and Records confirming your completion of the certificate requirement is the State of California Department of Health Services application for the PHN certificate. The state charges \$35 for this certificate. Attach your check and mail the completed application to the State of California. You will receive a certificate approximately 6 weeks after the state processes your application.

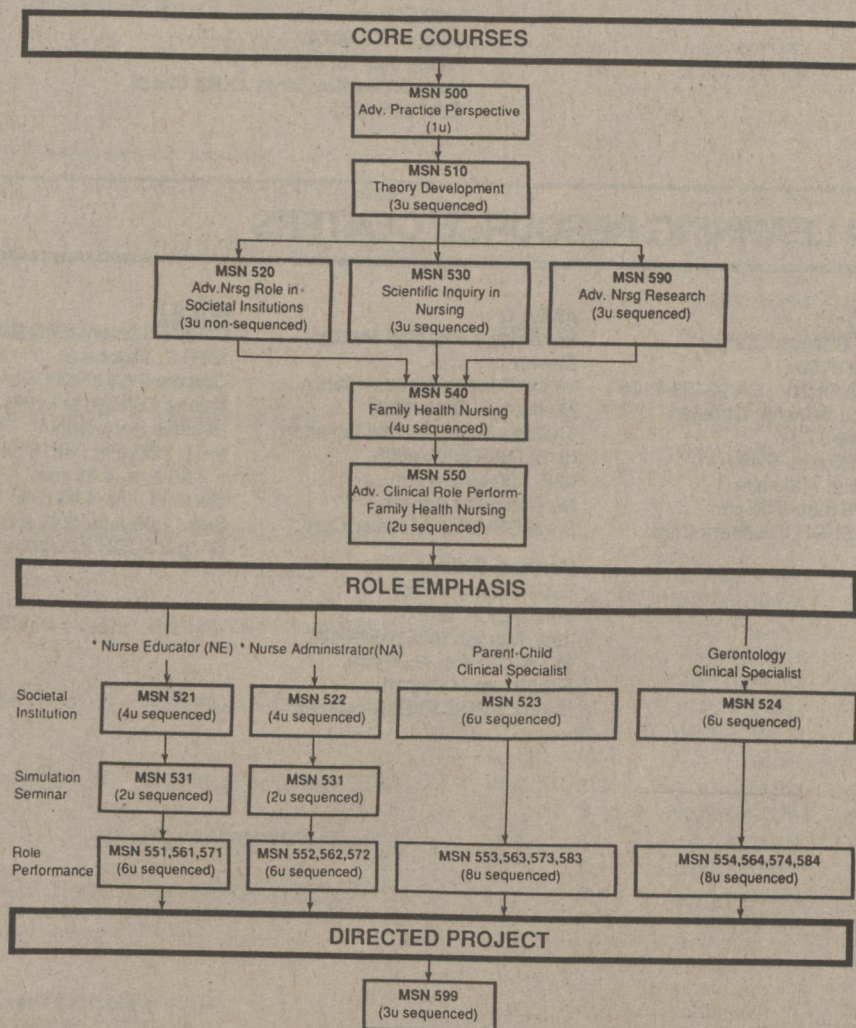

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

For the Bachelor's Degree

Undergraduate Transfer Students

You will qualify for admission as a transfer student if you have a grade point average of 2.0(C) or better in all transferable units attempted, are in good standing at the last college or university attended:

1. You will meet the freshman admission requirements in effect for the term in which you are applying:

a. High School Graduates and/or in continuous attendance in an accredited college.

b. Have a qualifiable eligibility index for an American College Test (ACT) score or Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT).

c. Have a "C" or better in the courses of college preparatory subject requirements.

2. Students with an RN license number and less than 56 transferable semester units must be eligible according to these first-time freshman requirements. If a student does not meet the first-time freshman requirements, he/she may be considered for admission under the Undergraduate Preparatory Program (UPP).

3. Students who have completed at least 56 transferable semester (84 quarter) units and have made up any missing college preparatory subject requirements. Nonresidents must have a 2.4 grade point average or better.

For this section, transferable courses are those designated for that purpose by the college or university offering the courses.

MAKING UP MISSING COLLEGE PREPARATORY SUBJECT REQUIREMENTS

Undergraduate applicants who did not complete the subject requirements while in high school may make up missing subjects by any of the following ways:

1. Complete appropriate courses with a C or better in adult school or high school summer sessions.
 2. Complete appropriate college courses with a C or better.
 3. Earn acceptable scores on specified examinations.
 4. 1987 or earlier high school graduates with 56 or more semester units may complete with a C or better in each course for the CSU general education requirements in communication in English language (at least 9 semester units) and mathematics (usually 3 semester units).
- In good standing at the last institution attended.
 - Current R.N. licensure or interim permit is required for enrollment in degree objective. Interim permit allows enrollment in BSN 310 and support courses only.

Diploma School Graduates see Undergraduate Preparatory Program.

Admissions applications are processed as they are received by the Admissions and Records Office. Apply as soon as possible to facilitate transcript evaluation procedure.

THE MAXIMUM TRANSFERABLE CREDIT FROM A TWO-YEAR COLLEGE IS 70 SEMESTER UNITS.

For the Master's Degree /QA Certificate

- Completion of a bachelor's degree in nursing from an accredited institution.
- A grade point average of 2.5 or higher in the last 60 semester (90 quarter) units attempted.
- In good standing at the last institution attended.
- Current R.N. licensure.
- Non BSN baccalaureate graduates see MSN pathway.
- Please note that beginning fall 1985 lower division courses and extension courses completed after the bachelor's degree will be excluded from the GPA calculation. Upper division course work taken through OPEN UNIVERSITY will be included in the GPA calculation.

For the PHN Public Health Certificate

- Completion of a non-NLN BSN degree, foreign BSN degree, or a BA/BS related degree
- Copy of the R.N. license
- All previous transcripts

APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

To apply for admission:

- Request an admissions packet from the admissions office. Complete the CSU Admission Application.
- Send it to the Admissions and Records Office with a \$45.00 check or money order (this fee is **nonrefundable**).
- Contact the college(s) and/or university(s) you have attended in the past and have official transcripts sent to the Admissions and Records Office. (For transcripts to be considered official, they must be received **directly** from the institution in an embossed sealed envelope.)

It is also recommended that you have a second set of transcripts sent to you for your personal portfolio for use by yourself and your advisor in developing a program of study.

APPLICATION FILING

Admission applications must be submitted at least two weeks prior to registration for the first course. Having submitted the Application, students must register for courses during the term for which they have applied while waiting for notice of formal admission. **However, students may not continue to register for classes in subsequent terms until their admission status has been validated.**

ADMISSION VALIDATION

In order to validate your admission status, **all application materials** must be in the Admissions and Records Office one month prior to the end of the term for which you are applying. Failure to file complete, accurate and authentic application documents may result in denial of admission, cancellation of academic credit, suspension or expulsion (Section 41301, Article 1.1, Title 5, California Administrative Code). Students will receive notification of admission status from the Admissions and Records Office.

Please note that an application for admission is valid for only one term. If all materials are not received by the prescribed deadlines the application will be inactivated and students will need to re-apply for admission.

SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER

Applicants are required to include their Social Security account number in designated places on applications for admission and registration form pursuant to the authority contained in Title 5, California Administration Code, Section 41201. The Social Security account number is used as a means of identifying records pertaining to the student as well as identifying the student for purposes of financial aid eligibility and disbursement and the repayment of financial aid and other debts payable to the institution.

REGISTRATION & FEES

Registration Instructions

Registration Process — Summer Session 1990 Continuing Students.

1. Complete the registration form. Be sure to include the correct schedule number, course number and title, time and location for each course/module.
2. Make your check payable to CSU Dominguez Hills. Include your charge card number and expiration date if you use VISA or MasterCard. Fees are not considered paid until your check has cleared the bank.
3. If your fees are being paid by a sponsoring agency or company which prefers to pay the CSU fees directly, you must secure a purchase order from the sponsor. The purchase order must be complete and accurate and addressed to the Summer Sessions Office, CSU Dominguez Hills. Submit the purchase order at the same time that you register for classes.
4. Classes not paid for will not be recorded on your transcript. You may not register for a subsequent semester if there are any outstanding University fees.
5. All Summer 1990 registrations for continuing students must be postmarked by June 15.
6. You may not attend a class without submitting the Registration Form and fees ahead of time. You may not late register for a unit or begin a class after the first class meeting has occurred.
7. Class size is limited. Seats go to eligible students as registrations are received.

To Register in Person

You can register in person at the Summer Sessions Office located on the CSU Dominguez Hills campus, SCC B141. The Summer Sessions Office accepts check, money order, cash (exact change), VISA and MasterCard.

LATE REGISTRATION

(For adding courses to a program, see Add/Drop instructions)
The late registration period begins July 2. Completion of late registration is dependent upon availability of seats for each class and is subject to a \$25.00 late registration fee.

ADD-DROP PROCESS SUMMER SESSIONS 1990

While some adding and dropping of courses can be accommodated, the program can best serve you by scheduling courses based on what students originally plan to take at the beginning of the Session. If you find it necessary to deviate from your original registration plan, you may add or drop a course without penalty if the Summer Sessions Office is notified at least 10 working days prior to the first class meeting date.

Adding Courses

To add classes after your initial Summer registration, please mail or FAX an Add/Drop Form to the Summer Sessions Office at least 10 working days prior to the first class session. Be sure to complete all the required information or the form cannot be processed and it will be returned to the student. Tuition payment for additional courses must accompany the Add/Drop request.

Late Adds

Students who do not meet the deadline for 10 working days:

1. May add the class only with the Instructor's permission. Note: There may not be seating availability.
2. You may not add a class after the first class session has started.

3. You must submit the Add/Drop form immediately after the first class session in order to have your name listed on the final grade roster.

4. Your payment for the additional courses must accompany the Add/Drop request.

Dropping Courses

Non-attendance in a class, notifying the instructor or stopping payment on a check does not officially constitute dropping or withdrawing from a course. The Summer Sessions Office must be notified and the Add/Drop form must be filed. **Penalty — If you do not send in the Add/Drop form, you will receive an unauthorized withdrawal — "U" — on your transcript.** This form must be received in the Summer Sessions Office within one week after the first class session.

Remember: If you are dropping a class and are entitled to a refund, you must sign the Request for Refund statement on the bottom of the Add/Drop form.

Cancelled Course Policy

If it is necessary to cancel a class or to make any changes in the scheduled class, every effort will be made to notify you by telephone at least five working days prior to the first meeting of that class. If a course is over enrolled and it is possible to add another section, you will be notified at least five days prior to the first meeting of the added class section, its location and possibly a new date and time depending on instructor availability.

If you are enrolled in a course that is cancelled and arrangements to add another course cannot be made, you must complete the Request for Refund statement on the bottom of the Add/Drop form and send it to the Summer Sessions Office. **The University does not refund fees automatically in the event of a course cancellation.**

REFUND POLICY

Refunds are not automatic. You must submit the Request for Refund statement on the bottom of the Add/Drop form to have your tuition fees refunded. Amounts of refunds are calculated according to the formula for refunds established in Title 5 of the California Administrative Code.

1. If your request for refund is postmarked prior to the first day of the class session, you will receive total tuition minus \$10.00.
2. If your Request for Refund is postmarked on the first day of the class session or on the day immediately following the first day of the class session you will receive total tuition minus the fee for one unit.
3. If your Request for Refund is postmarked during the remainder of the first week of the class session, you will receive total tuition minus one unit times 65%.
4. If your Request for Refund is postmarked after the first week of the class session, none of the fees are refundable.

TUITION AND FEES

Fees and refunds are subject to change by the Trustees of the California State University. Full payment of all tuition and fees must be made at the time of registration or adding a course. Summer tuition is the same for legal residents and nonresidents of California.
