B. A&H Cultural/Gender Taxation Study

- Study investigates faculty stalled at Associate level, collect how many faculty members impacted, amount that is female faculty, people of color, how long at range, move toward full professor.
- Taxation of service impacts moving to another rank
- How do we address cultural and gender taxation?
- Actions specific to our college working with Marisela to support faculty
- Posting the service of faculty members on college site
- Would like the statement to come from the College instead of Jenn
- Not all the service is recognized and awarded; there is work that the faculty does that many do not know about (example personally counselling students)
- Factors of the additional assistance include population of students, sexual misconduct, female students come to female faculty for help

- Labor Studies, Communications, Music, Art and Design, Theater and Dance, English, Modern Languages, Chicano Studies, IDS, and Asian Pacific Studies all applied for searches.
- Factors considered in faculty searches: College moving away from micro departments (only 1 tenure track faculty member), pressing accreditation, growth in the major, stable lecturer core while we search or wait to search for TT
- Request to have these factors for considering a search in writing and published
