
# ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS REPORT, WHAT IS IT? WHERE CAN I FIND IT?


Your Academic Requirements Report (ARR) provides you with a list of graduation requirements. It allows you to see what you have completed, what you are taking, and what you still need to take. For example, General Education requirements (transferred or taken at CSUDH), Units, Major Courses, etc.

You can find your Academic Requirements Report in your MyCSUDH account in various places.

1. On your Student Center, under Other Academics

2. In your Smart Planner, under Academic Requirements Report





Your Plan: This is your declared major. If you have a minor or 2<sup>nd</sup> bachelor, it will be listed below.

Expected graduation date: Once you apply for graduation, your intended graduation semester will go here. If you have not applied, it will be blank.

Graduation Status: This will change as your degree is being reviewed for graduation. Usually during your last semester.

Academic Standing: This provides you with your academic standing.

Overall GPA: Transfer students will have a GPA from their community college. Freshman students will most likely have the same GPA for both areas since they take their GE courses at CSUDH.

CSUDH GPA: This only includes courses taken at CSUDH.

Green Checkmark: Requirement has been met

Yellow Diamond: Course is in progress; units are not counted towards the total completed yet.

Red Square: Requirement has not been met yet.

This Academic Advising Report is available only for degree seeking students. If you are not currently a degree-seeking student you will only have access to your course history. In addition, it does not cover students pursuing Certificates or Credentials. These symbols appear to the right of each requirement and indicate the status of the student's degress progress. All "in


progress" courses must be completed to graduate.


Course Icons




This area provides information on Overall Graduation Requirements, such as, Statutory (HIS and POL), GPA, GWAR, Units
