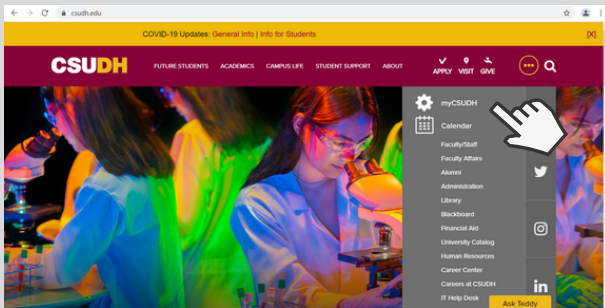


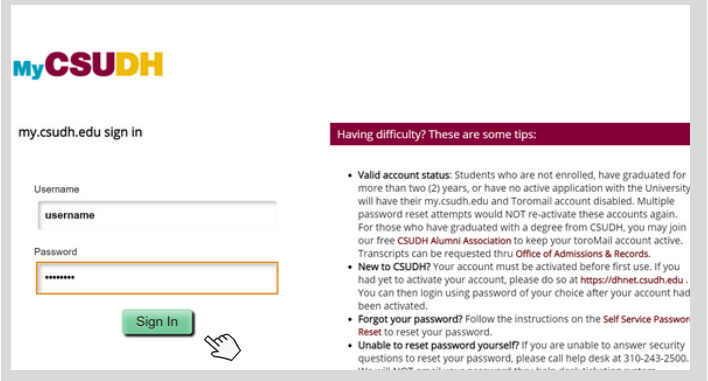
HOW TO: Search Lower Division GE Courses

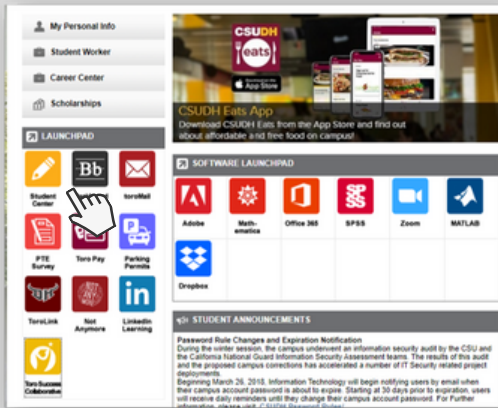
1. Go to www.csudh.edu, find the three dots & click on "myCSUDH"



2. Enter Student Username & Password



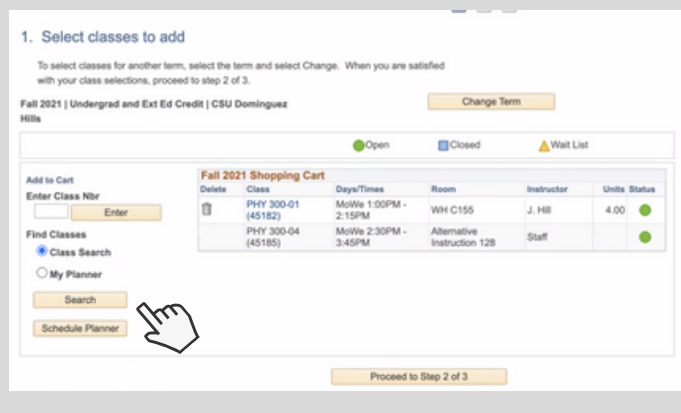
3. Click the "Student Center" Icon (Yellow Pencil)



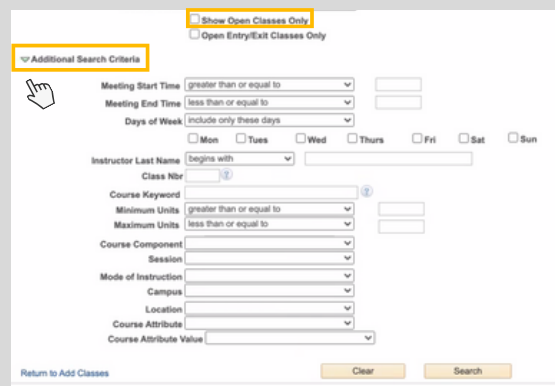
4. Click on "Enroll" on the left side under Academics
