## **Program Admission Requirements**

- Official transcripts of all colleges with degree posted. CSUDH Alums not required, except for all other institutions
  - Sealed copy or electronic copy to be sent to University Admissions <u>admissions@csudh.edu</u> or CSUDH Office of Admissions & Records, 1000 E. Victoria St., Carson, CA 90747
  - Official opened copy to be uploaded to the COE Supplemental Program Application. CSUDH Alums upload unofficial copy
- 2.75 GPA in the last 60 semester units attempted or 2.50 in all baccalaureate and postbaccalaureate course work
- ☐ Verification of Passed Basic Skills Required for admission (options below)
  - CBEST California Basic Educational Skills Test
  - CSET and Writing
  - Qualifying Coursework Evaluation
  - Combination of Qualifying Coursework and CBEST exam by Evaluation
  - CSU Early Assessment Program or CSU Placement (AP) exam
  - Qualifying Score on the SAT or ACT College Board Advanced Placement (AP) Exam
- □ Copy of valid <u>Certificate of Clearance</u>, emergency, substitute permit, or pre-intern credential. <u>Live Scan form</u> must be filed with the State of California, Commission on Teacher Credentialing (allow 10 days for processing)
- ☐ CPR Certification Areas must include infant, child and adult CPR. Online certification is acceptable.
- Evidence of current negative TB test results or chest x-ray, no older than 4 years at the time of start term as well as applicant name, DOB, and clinic information or stamp
- Verification of U.S. Constitution requirement (options below)
  - CSU graduates meet this requirement upon completion of a bachelor's degree
  - US Government course(s) may be accepted with a grade of C or better
  - POL 101 Challenge Exam (when offered) \$25 Challenge Exam
  - Online thru Notre Dame \$85 <u>US Constitution Exam</u>
- □ <u>Subject Matter</u> Verification of meeting subject matter or <u>continuous progress towards subject matter</u> form must be submitted with your online application
- ☐ Letters of Recommendations Recommendation Form
  - Provide two professional recommendations using the specific form
  - Recommendations must be completed by a faculty member, employer, or someone that is knowledgeable regarding the applicant's personal qualities and ability to work with children
  - Recommendations from family members and friends are not acceptable
