- **Project Updates**

- **EAB:**

- New advising tool currently being used by a pilot group; expected to roll out in Fall for everybody.

- **On-Base:**

- Scanning software with testing to start in November for 2 to 3 weeks (A&R, Financial Aid, HR, Procurement and COE) and go-live in December.

- **Others:**

- Data Dashboard and student success rolled out to select group

- **Maintenance Packs:**

- Currently in MP 14

- **Purging reports from CMS**

- **Learning Mode:**

- From the Office of the Chancellor: Currently, the Academic Planning Database (APBD) reporting data element of Learning Mode only has three values to identify a course's instruction type. As more variety is found in instruction, more distinct values to identify the Learning Mode of these courses are needed. Nine new values have been defined to more distinctly identify a course's Learning Mode. Starting the Summer 2015 reporting cycle, the APBD data element of Learning Mode will be extracted from the PeopleSoft Instruction Mode field on the Maintain Schedule of Classes component. As campuses have likely used the Instruction Mode for its own local purposes, CMS will be delivering a mapping table to which campuses will map existing values to the new nine Learning Mode values.
