CSUDH is dedicated to protecting its students, faculty, and staff during an emergency. Following is a list of tools that CSUDH provides.

ToroAlert: CSUDH's mass emergency communication system can send time-sensitive information about unforeseen events and emergencies using voice, email, and text messaging to all faculty, staff, and students.

Outdoor Broadcasting System: This system is intended to alert people who are outdoors and is not designed to be heard inside buildings. Real-time messages and emergency instructions can be broadcast.

Emergency Blue Light Phones: Blue phones are located throughout the campus and are linked directly to University Police dispatch.

CSUDH Website: Emergency information will be uploaded to the campus website.

Vehicle Public Address Systems: University vehicles with PA systems may be used to augment other methods of communication.

University Police: University Police are on duty 24/7 to respond to any campus emergency.
