Custodial Services Training and Procedures

Safety Risks

- Potential presence of bacterial and viral disease agents.
- Potential radiation risks from x-ray machinery
- Presence of sharps including needles, razors, syringes.
- Presence of body fluids including blood and saliva.

Custodian training

- Custodians assigned to the SHC shall complete Blood Borne Pathogen (BBP) training prior to assignment.
- Custodians shall complete an orientation that includes a walk-through of the facility with SHC staff, prior to assignment.
- All Federal and state guidelines shall be followed during cleaning of the SHC.

Custodial Service and Frequencies

California State University, Dominguez Hills, Facilities Services cleans based on a priority system. Each task is assigned a cleaning frequency. Listed below are our tasks and frequencies.

Restrooms

Restrooms are disinfected and cleaned as follows:

- 1. Sweep floor daily
- 2. Wet mop floor daily
- 3. Walls and partitions cleaned daily
- 4. High dust daily
- 5. Toilets and urinals cleaned daily
- 6. Mirrors cleaned daily
- 7. Empty trash receptacles and change liners daily
- 8. Clean all chrome fixtures daily
- 9. Replenish paper products and soap daily
- 10. Clean door handles and door plates daily

Hallways and Corridors

Hallways and corridors are cleaned as follows:

- 1. Dust mop or back pack vacuum floor daily
- 2. Sweep and mop floor daily
- 3. Clean baseboards daily
- 4. Disinfect and clean drinking fountains daily
- 5. Entry doors glass cleaned daily
- 6. Kick plates and door frames cleaned as needed
- 7. Walls dusted and/or spot cleaned weekly
- 8. Empty trash receptacles and change liners daily

Stairwells

Stairwells are cleaned as follows:

- 1. Sweep or back pack vacuum stairs daily
- Damp/spot mop stairs daily
- 3. Dust and clean hand rails daily
- 4. Dust and spot clean walls daily or as needed
- 5. Spot clean doors daily

Examination Rooms / Surgery Rooms

Examination rooms and Surgery rooms are cleaned as follows:

- 1. Empty trash receptacles and change liners daily
- 2. Sinks cleaned and disinfected daily
- 3. Soap and paper supplies replenished daily
- 4. Horizontal surfaces dusted and disinfected daily
- 5. Trash receptacles washed weekly
- 6. Door hardware cleaned and disinfected weekly

Labs / Recovery Rooms

Labs / Recovery rooms are cleaned as follows:

- 1. Dust mop or back pack vacuum floor daily
- 2. Mop floors daily
- 3. Floors swept (or vacuumed), hard surfaces mopped using disinfectant (recovery rooms) daily
- 4. Empty trash receptacles and change liners daily
- 5. Horizontal surfaces dusted and disinfected daily

- 6. Empty pencil sharpeners daily
- 7. Clean white boards daily
- 8. Spot walls and doors daily
- 9. Damp mop floor weekly
- 10. Wash or dust window sills weekly
- 11. High dusting weekly
- 12. Clean table tops weekly or as needed
- 13. Wash trash receptacles weekly
- 14. Door hardware cleaned weekly

Offices and Conference Rooms

Department offices and conference rooms are cleaned as follows:

- 1. Empty trash receptacles and change liners daily
- 2. Dust mop or back pack vacuum floor daily
- 3. Dust all regular surfaces i.e. desk tops etc. weekly (Do not touch computers or personal items)
- 4. High dust weekly
- 5. Window treatments and sills cleaned weekly
- 6. Walls and doors dusted and spot cleaned weekly
- 7. Empty large recycle receptacles as needed
