Welcome & Introductions

- Meeting began at 10:00am.

Minutes Review

Regular Business

- **Michael** air purifiers
- **Jonathon** got C.A.R.E.S funding approval for HEPA filters air purifiers for the classrooms and offices. Lead time seems to be the trouble because massive supply chain is backed up currently.
- **Nasr** Will a campus wide announcement be made when they arrive? Unit 3 members have been inquiring about the air purifiers.
- **Jonathon** confirms announcement will be made to the campus.
- **Michael** in relation to the Protexus Sprayer training. Campus was able to procure 4 more Protexus Sprayer so we can outfit every custodian with Protexus Sprayer. We will need to make sure every custodian is trained on it. Deon was made aware, however, is currently out this week.
- **Jonathon** funding for 50 more sprayers, so the campus will have plenty of back ups
- **Michael** discussion b/w Jonathon and Deon are working on general training for cleaning. Campus got funding approved to make a video for the training session for facilities related to COVID protocols.
- **Michael** ergonomic and injury prevention form was sent out to all MPPs. Managers can apply for funding for support through EHS
- **Michael** the fire sticks were removed off campus, the deadline was Aug 31st, 2001.
- **Jonathon** confirms that that they were removed.

COVID 19

- **Michael** address that we are in week 1
- **Nasr** asked Michael if he has any info on COVID in respect to other campuses in the CSU system. Does Michael have discussions with his counterparts in relation to COVID. It has been mentioned at other campuses that they have had difficulty with the Delta Variant.
- **Michael** CSUDH and LA area is doing great. San Diego state is having more difficulty. Testing has been ramped up, especially with students moving back into housing, 1100 people are planning to get tested overall. Michael reviews charts with committee related to COVID19 cases around

the CSU system.

- **Michael** school in general K-12 are supposed to be wearing mask. Mask wearing for Higher Ed is based on county.
- **Kiem** How are we going to keep track of enforcement of mask wearing on campus? Kiem has seen higher management not wear mask and go from floor to floor.
- **Michael** has gone all the way to the president's office multiple times over accountability on people wearing mask. Has yet to see discipline used as an option.
- **Shaun** there is no written disciplinary action. We should be able to have options as far as directing people where to get a mask on campus if they forgot theirs.
- **Khiem** asked if disciplinary action could be an option.
- **Lee** had mask available at her table in front of the II building for those who had forgotten. Sometimes people may have an incident that
- **Michael** Work Control can be called to provide face mask. Additionally, we do have locations around campus that do provide such as the police department, athletics, etc.
- **Nasr** Asked Michael if two other campuses have had similar returned back to campus like CSUDH. San Diego is back at 20% population like CSUDH.
