First-year Requirements

- Receive a minimum A-G GPA of 2.5 or higher for California residents or graduates of California high schools (3.0 for non-California residents)
- Must complete all A-G college preparatory coursework with grades of C- or better
- Must graduate from high school or equivalent

Transfer Student Requirements

- Be in good standing at the last college or university attended and eligible to re-enroll
- College GPA of 2.0 or higher
- Completed 6 transferable semester units (8 quarter units) of general education courses, graded C- or better in each course including:
 - » Complete College Level English
 - » Complete College Level Mathematics

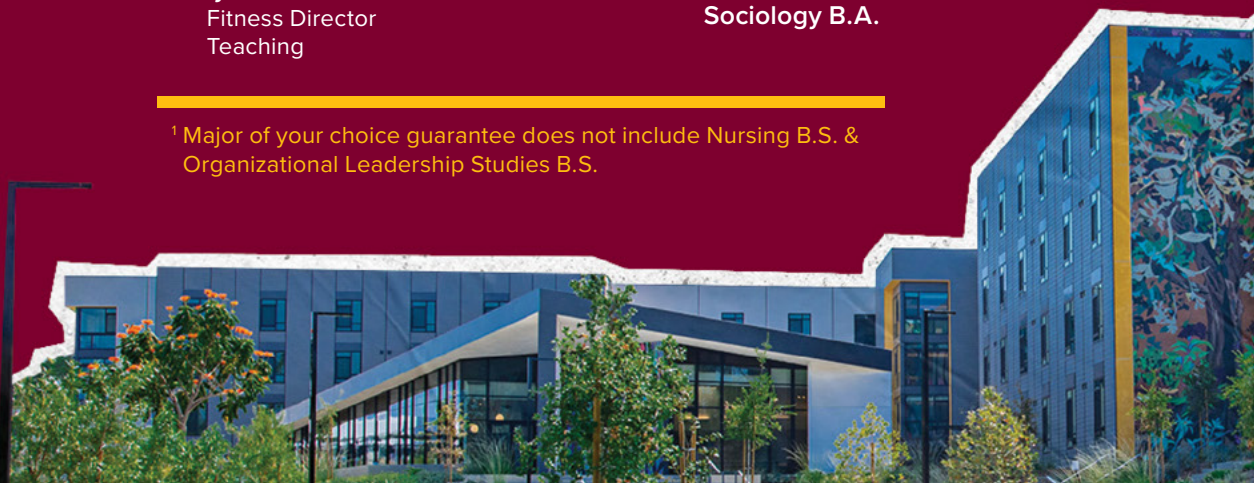
