The NSF GRFP is a fellowship program that directly supports students in various STEM fields, including social science and STEM education. Each Fellowship provides 3-years of support during a 5-year fellowship period. For each of the 3 years of support, NSF provides a \$37,000 stipend and a \$16,000 cost of education allowance to the graduate degree-granting institution of higher education. This information session is especially for seniors applying to graduate school next year. An overview of the application process, tips for strengthening your application, and developing a timeline for productive writing and submission will be discussed.
