Before the COVID pandemic, hardcopy documents were

routinely delivered to Human Resources for processing purposes. The [COVID] shutdown highlighted the weakness of having a paper process in place.

We quickly **partnered with IT** to integrate **secure Dropbox folders**.

As a result, we revolutionized the HRrelated document submission process to our office, enabling us to receive **digital copies** uploaded to Dropbox.

Curriculum Review Process

Our curriculum review process has always essentially been paper-based, even during the pandemic; it involved manually moving pdf files step by step through the curriculum workflow, then manually inputting approved changes into the Catalog.

To **streamline** and move this process fully **online**, the Office of Academic Programs collaborated with the Division of IT to clarify the curriculum review workflow, eliminate redundancies, and choose a catalog and curriculum management software that would offer a product that would best meet the campus' needs. Ultimately, we chose CourseLeaf.

G G The result will be an impressive 80% reduction in manual

data entry requirements upon full implementation. \Box \Box



This product will provide departments and colleges with greater autonomy over the way their curriculum appears in the Catalogue and transparency throughout the curriculum review process.

Electronic Medical Records & Telehealth



Our cross-divisional collaboration with DIT has resulted in numerous benefits for the SHC. These include a robust electronic medical record-keeping system, updated technology and tools, and secure storage of protected health information via Dropbox. The introduction of telehealth services through Dropbox allowed us to quickly receive essential documents needed for quality medical and mental healthcare.

The Toro Success Collaborative or TSC is an **online tool that connects students with services on campus**. Through a campus wide effort between Academic Affairs, Student Affairs and Division of Information Technology, the TSC platform has grown tremendously over the past three years.



Originally utilized for tutoring purposes, the platform has **expanded to incorporate all advising services** and most recently the onboarding of CSUDH's many **cultural and identity centers**.

Business Process Improvement (BPI)



In Academic Affairs, we partnered with DIT to implement the Business Process Implementation (BPI) methodology. We have begun **evaluating** our **current business processes** for **paying faculty** for **off-contract work** using this process. Although we are still early in the process and have not integrated it into daily operations, it has helped us understand our methods.

With the Covid shutdown, we had to reassess our paper processes. In the near future, I aspire to **integrate processes** in which the original request is **automatically entered** into the ultimate **data system**, and the rest of the workflow is designed solely to gather approvals.
