#### **GENERAL ADVISING INFORMATION:**

There are four types of courses you need to take to graduate:

- 1. General Education (G.E.) courses
- 2. Statutory requirements (HIS 101 and POL 101)
- 3. Graduation Writing Assessment Requirement
- 4. Major courses

Students must earn 120 units to graduate, including but not limited to all of the courses in the categories above. These 120 units must include:

- At least 30 units at CSUDH
- At least 40 upper-division units
- At least 24 upper-division units at CSUDH

### **General Education (G.E.) notes:**
