CLEARANCES	REOUIRED FOR F	TIELD PLACEMENTS

In both years of field placement, the California Title IV-E Education Stipend Program student will be placed in child welfare related agencies. Most often, the first year is in a non-profit agency serving Title IV-E eligible children and families. The second year field placement will be in a public child welfare office. Therefore, all second year California Title IV-E Education Stipend Program student interns will be expected to meet all requirements and clearances required of public child welfare agencies. Those include:

- Submit to and pass a background clearance
- Submit to and pass physical exam
- Submit to and pass psychological exam.

Because non-profit agencies are also working with children, youth and families, many will also require a background clearance. If the agency requires a background clearance but does not provide the resources to do so, any costs associated with obtaining a background clearance will be the responsibility of the student. (Should this be the case, the California Title IV-E Education Stipend Program Project Coordinator can assist you in locating an agency that can provide this service.) Individuals who have a criminal background <u>may or may not</u> be excluded from certain agencies. In order to determine if a criminal record might prevent eligibility for a placement, please answer the following questions:

(All responses will be kept confidential and will be shared only for the purposes of determining field placement eligibility.)

- 1. Have you ever been convicted of a crime? (includes misdemeanor and/or felony) _____ yes _____ no (If your response is no, you may skip the remaining questions and sign and date form at the bottom of page.)
- 2. Please identify any and all convictions and provide the following information for each:
 - a. What was the official conviction?
 - b. In what State were you arrested/convicted?
 - c. Was conviction a felony or misdemeanor?
 - d. When were you convicted (please provide month/year)?
 - e. Results of conviction (incarceration, probation, parole)?
 - f. If you were on probation or parole, when did it conclude?
 - g. Have you met all the stipulations of the Court or is anything still pending?
 - h. Will your conviction show up on a Live Scan or other background clearance check?

3. Please provide any additional information that you believe might prevent you from meeting the required clearances outlined above.

As previously stated, there are some convictions and other circumstances (e.g., length of time since the conviction) that will not negatively effect a student's placement in an agency. However, failure to disclose a criminal background may impact our ability to place a student in an appropriate California Title IV-E Education Stipend Program field placement. As a result, the student may not be able to successfully meet the requirements of the California Title IV-E Education Stipend Program as it relates to field experience. Should this occur, the student would be required to pay back any stipend monies received thus far.

Please be advised that if you have previously been convicted of a crime and have gone through the process of expunging it from your record, you are strongly encouraged to disclose that information to us. It has been our experience that expunged convictions may/will be identified in a criminal background check. Failure to disclose a criminal background is grounds for removal from the California Title IV-E Education Stipend Program and the MSW Program. In addition, should you be convicted of a crime after submission of this form and while participating in the MSW Program, you are required to notify the Project Coordinator.
